2017: Information regarding special education teaching support in our school

We are delighted to inform you that the Special Education Teacher (SET) team in our school facilitates the innovative support of learning at all levels of ability, in and outside the classroom.

The SET team will continue working collaboratively with class teachers and parents to ensure a whole school approach to your child's education.

As part of our yearly programme we aim to provide support to individuals, groups and whole classes.

In-class group work in the classroom with the class teacher.

The SET team will, at times, assist the class teacher in various ways e.g. a team may assist in the classroom for a specified period of time or one teacher may support children in the classroom dealing with a specific area of learning. This may happen at different times during the year.

Special Education Teacher Working With Individuals/ Groups

Support in literacy and numeracy takes place in the SET room. At times, support in literacy and numeracy may be in the form of in-class group work and during these times your child will not be withdrawn from the classroom. Your child may, if required, attend classes in the SET room, in the halla, or in the school yard, assisting in developing fine motor skills, gross motor skills, communication skills, social skills or behaviour management.

Prior permission from parents/ guardians will continue to be sought by the class teachers, for children availing of this support. At all times, the assigned special education teacher will consult and liaise with you and the class teacher.

As part of our social skills programme your child may, on occasion, assist others in developing their social skills in small groups in the SET room or in the yard at break time. Prior permission will not be sought for this.
